New world quail, such as Bobwhites, grow larger than old world quail, but they take twice as long to reach mature size (~16 weeks) than Old World quail (~7-8 weeks).

Presence of light increase the egg productive efficiency of quails. They usually lay eggs at afternoon. It takes about 17 days to hatch their eggs.

Leucine is a branched chain amino acid along with valine and isoleucine.
