Respiratory System: Facts, Function and Diseases. The primary organs of the respiratory system are lungs, which carry out this exchange of gases as we breathe. Red blood cells collect the oxygen from the lungs and carry it to the parts of the body where it is needed, according to the American Lung Association.

REGULATION AND CONTROL OF BREATHING: In order to maintain normal levels of partial oxygen and carbon dioxide pressure both the depth and rate of breathing are precisely regulated. Basic elements of the respiratory control system are (1) strategically placed sensors (2) central controller (3) respiratory muscles.

These are the major parts of the respiratory system:
Nasal cavity The passage for air entering and leaving the lungs.
Cilia The lining of the nasal cavity. These are tiny hair-like structures that trap the small particles of dust and foreign matter that don't belong in the lungs.

The Heart is made of cardiac muscle and is surrounded by pericardium. It is composed of 4 chambers. The 2 upper chambers (atria) receive blood and the lower 2 chambers (ventricles) pump blood out. Heart valves, located between the chambers, prevent the back flow of blood.
